TOURIST ATTRACTIONS



The most popular places for tourists in Australia are the Great Barrier Reef, Sydney, Ayers Rock and the Kakadu National Park.

The Great Barrier Reef...

...is the largest coral reef in the world. It's more than 3000km long. The reef is ideal for scuba diving, snorkelling and fishing. You can also watch the thousands of fish from a boat with a glass bottom.



Sydney...

...is the largest and oldest city in Australia, it is also one of the most beautiful cities in the world. There are many parks and hills with a wonderful view on the blue sea and the boats. The most famous building in Sydney is the Opera House, which looks like a huge sailing boat.



Ayers Rock...

...is a huge red rock. It is about 350m high and it's possible to climb it. For the Aborigines who live there this is a holy place and so they don't really like tourists climbing to the top. The indigenous people call this rock Uluru. There is a wonderful view from the top.



The Kakadu National Park...

...is located in northern Australia and covers an area of about 6000km². There is so much to see, for example the very dangerous crocodiles in the rivers. There are also several cave paintings which may be more than 20000 years old.
